- Support liaison and collaboration with donor(s) and with institutional and non-institutional partners concerned with FAO Programme in Kosovo, including private sector, NGOs, academia and civil society;
- Participate in the UNKT coordination meetings, working groups, reviews and consultations, as required by the Local Team Leader. for the development and implementation of the FAO Programme in Kosovo;
- Support FAO project office in Kosovo for a successful implementation of projects activities;
- Support the preparation of briefs and updates to FAO Management.
