


The reproduction/ transmission rate COVID-19 in Kosovo has risen at factor 1.05,

COVID-19 vaccines - Since the arrival of the first doses of the vaccine, the total number of vaccines in Kosovo has now reached 2,176,240 doses, funded by institutions and donations. UNICEF supported the Ministry of Health on developing a digitalized system for registering and of COVID-19 vaccine tracking

COVID-19 containment measures were last modified on 1 December based on the current data on the epidemiological situation and the recommendations of the IPH,

balancing the interest of preserving public health and economic interest, taking measures which on the one hand enable increased economic activity and on the other control and prevent distribution of COVID-19. The decision was published on the Ministry of Health website in three languages, in English, Albanian and Serbian.
