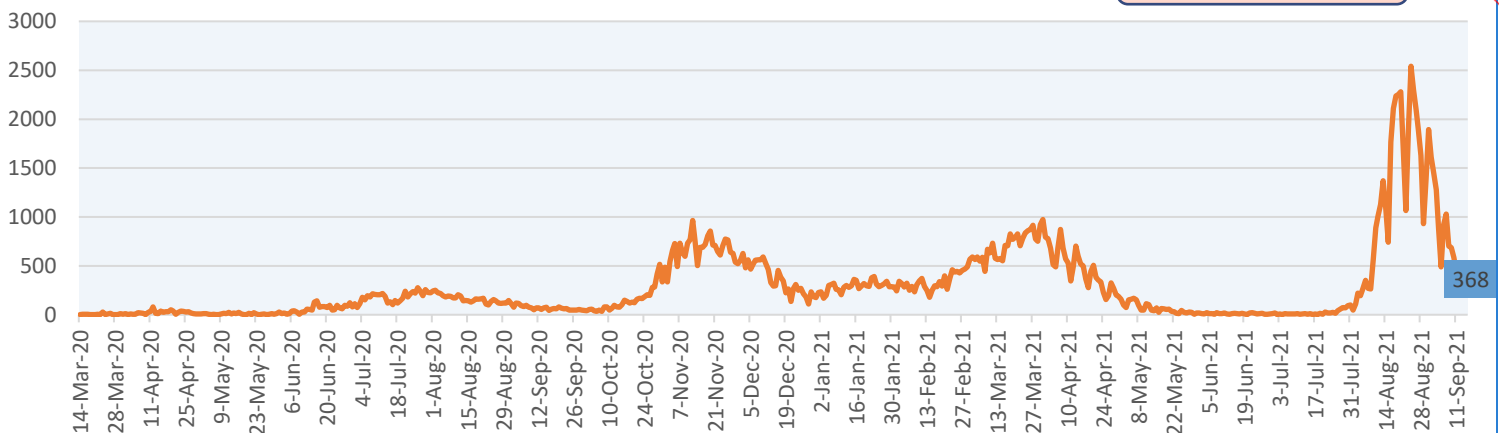

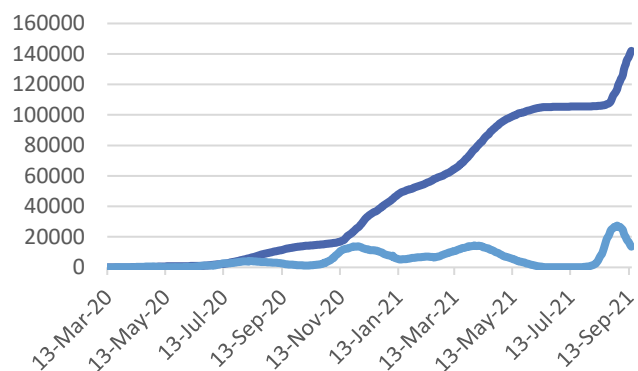

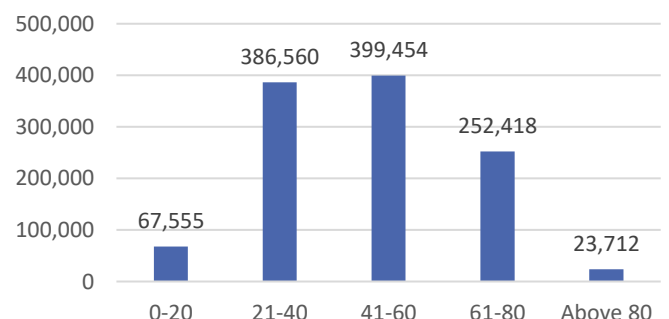
Number of immunisations by age.



<div><div>3</div><div>GOOD HEALTH AND WELL-BEING</div><div></div></div> <p>The reproduction/ transmission rate of COVID-19 in Kosovo has decreased to the factor 0.64. This means that 100 people will transmit the virus to 64 other people. To contain the pandemic, the undertaken measures need to keep the Reproduction rate to under factor 1.0. Currently the Case Reproduction rate is calculated by WHO Regional Office for Europe COVID-19 in a Daily Digest.</p>	<div><div></div><div>COVID-19 vaccines - Since the arrival of the first doses of the vaccine, the total number of vaccines that have arrived in Kosovo has now reached 1,725,410 doses, funded by institutions and donations. UNICEF supported the Ministry of Health on developing a digitalized system for registering and tracking of COVID-19 vaccine recipients. LINK, LINK, LINK</div></div>	<div><div></div><div>Latest COVID-19 containment measures have been last modified on 13 September based on the current data on the epidemiological situation and the recommendations of the IPH balancing the interest of preserving public health and economic interest, taking measures which on the one hand enable increased economic activity, while on the other hand control and prevent distribution of COVID-19. The decision was published on the Ministry of Health website in three languages, follow LINK for the new measures in English. And also see LINK in Albanian and LINK in Serbian.</div></div>
<div><div></div><div>15 September, UNHCR as the COVID-19 situation continues, the asylum procedures continuation will be supported also by remote interviewing modalities through videoconferencing. The newly established RSD interview room at the Ministry of Internal Affairs will enable virtual RSD interviews with the asylum seekers in both asylum centers, Magurë/and Vranidoll/Vrani Do. LINK</div></div>	<div><div></div><div>17 September, OHCHR - According to the new decision on COVID-19 measures, all employees of public institutions, as well as the staff of public enterprises, shall possess either a vaccination certificate, a negative COVID-19 test, or a COVID-19 recovery certificate, to be allowed entry in the workplace. Either of these documents is also required when using gyms, sports centers, and similar spaces for individual recreational activities. See full OHCHR article covering period 10-17 September. The Delta variant of concern spreads between people more efficiently than even the Alpha variant.


